CURRENT POLITICAL SITUATION


"I've been studying dictatorships and how dictators come to power for a few years now. One of the methods - not newly invented - can currently be observed in the USA... Purging political opponents from all posts with political responsibility; disempowerment of institutions in which professional competence confers authority and replacement of experts with loyalists from outside the field; elimination of the legal system; synchronisation of the press - now: social media; justification of all this as combating anti-popular ideologies; opposition is eliminated; personality cult, etc. Later comes total surveillance (which Musk will certainly be able to manage technically).

Goal: All power is concentrated in one person who behaves totally arbitrarily, because any kind of predictability of behaviour would represent a limitation of power (=predictability could be used)." Fritz B. Simon on LinkedIn (8.2.25 / see also his books on dictatorships etc. <u>here</u>)
